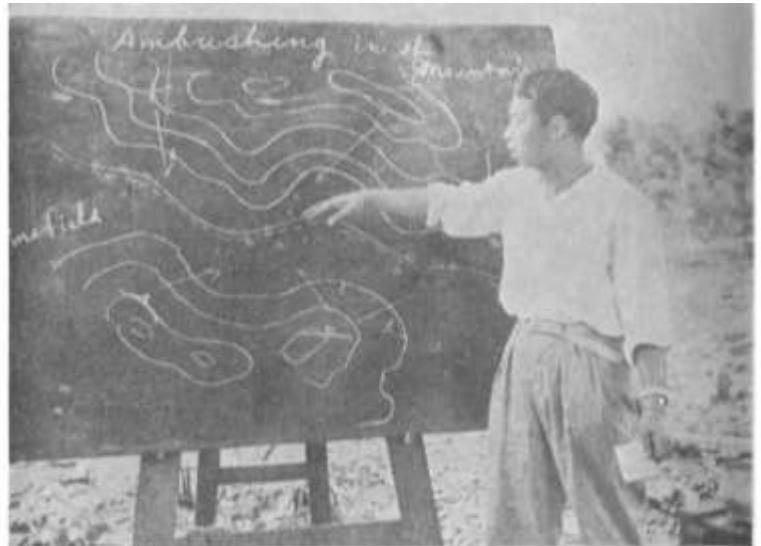

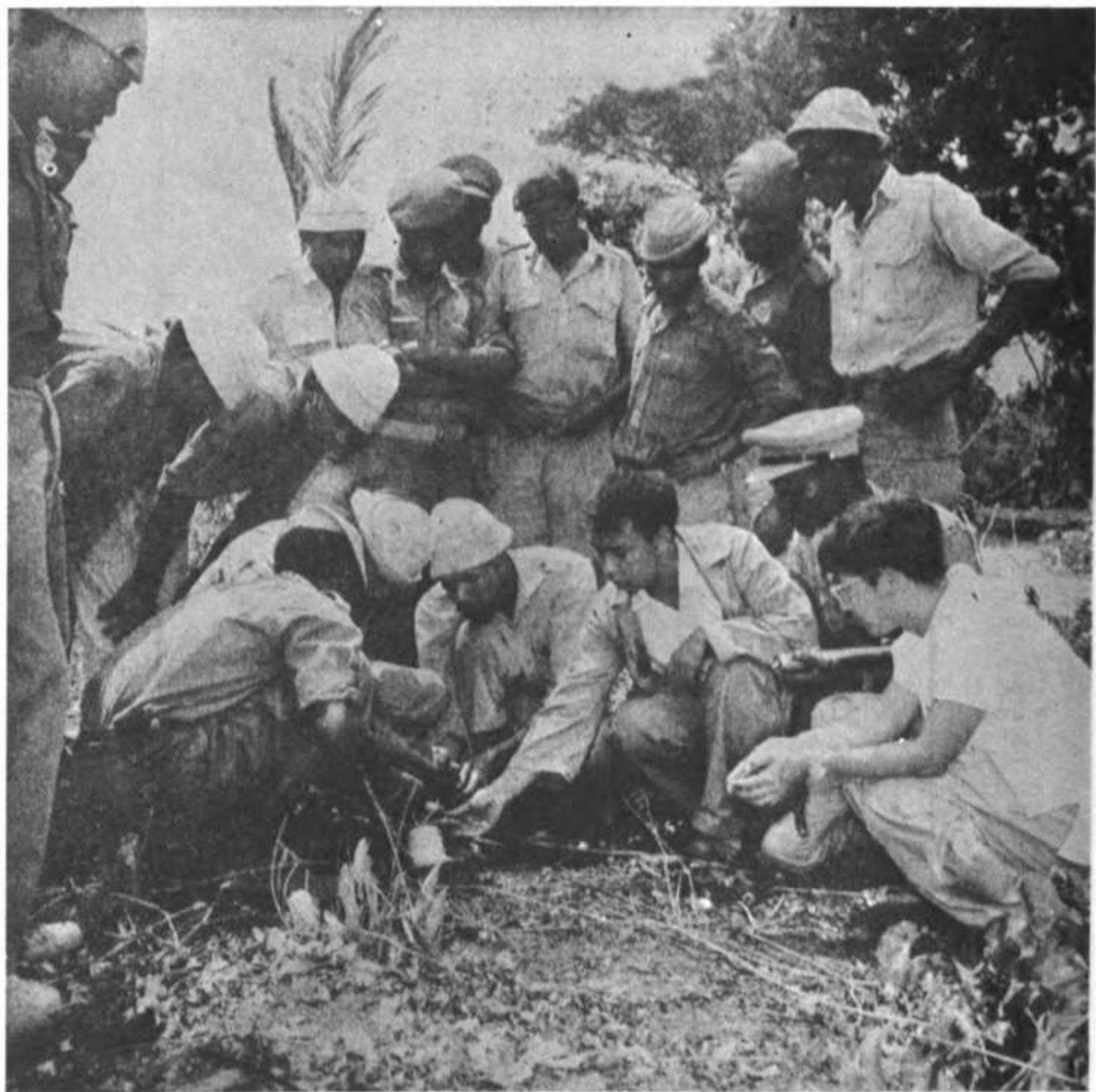

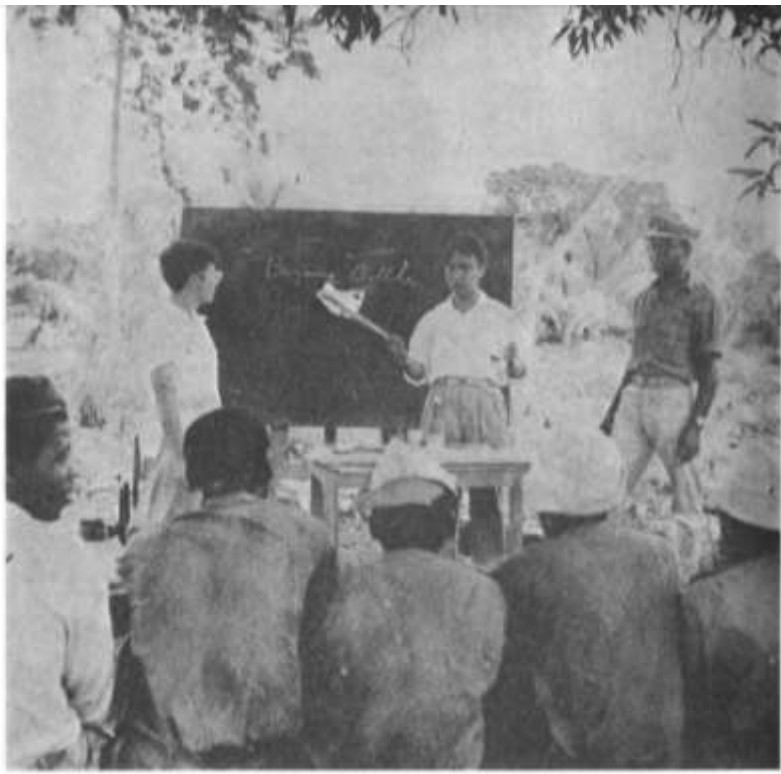


*Sr. Capt. Li Fu-kun Explosives Expert, gives a lecture on ambushing in mountains.*
