it China at the head of the delegation. We are sure that the friendship and solidarity between us will be further strengthened and developed through your visit," Comrade Li Hsien-nien concluded.

In his toast, Comrade Jurquet extended, on behalf of the Marxist-Leninist Communists of France, "our revolutionary and proletarian internationalist salute to you, respected Comrade Hua Kuo-feng, Chairman of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China; to Comrade Li Hsien-nien, Member of the Political Bureau of the C.P.C.
